Prince Edward Island is particularly suited for the production of fine wines, and as the Island's sole vintner, I invite you to glimpse "behind the curtains" to see how our artisan products are created.

It all starts with the Island's unique geography. The same red soil that grows the famed Island potato has a lot to do with the grapes, berries and other fruits we use for our award-winning varieties.

All 14 of our wines are based upon Island fruit, by the way, much of which is grown on our 20-acre property in Little Sands, overlooking the Northumberland Strait. Other fruit is carefully harvested and delivered by trusted neighbours at their own nearby farms.

We have four distinct seasons on Prince Edward Island, and successfully cultivate such grape varieties as Marechal Foch, L'Acadie and Valient.

The Island produces excellent berries, starting with strawberries in June, then raspberries, blackberries, blueberries and cranberries in quick succession. We also create interesting liqueurs and wines using Island apples, and maple syrup from Island orchards. When you visit our winery, just a few minutes drive from the Wood Islands ferry terminal, we'll show you the stainless steel vats, fruit presses, and oak barrels used in the various steps of small-batch artisan wine production. You'll also see original oils, acrylics and water colour paintings created by my wife Dagny and other area artists. Labels based on these works of art are carefully hand-positioned on each bottle, and we have wooden gift boxes made for us in nearby Montague.

Most importantly, we'll offer you a chance to sample some of our products, and give you our personal recommendations on pairing them with Island salads, seafood, meats, and desserts. That's your best way of finding out why Rossignol Winery has received so many awards since 1994. Whether you are travelling all the way from North Cape PE or somewhere on the Mainland, you'll be warmly welcomed at Rossignol Winery, any day of the week. We hope to see you soon.
